

*Road Traversing Maori Land Proclaimed as a Public Road in Block X, Motuotaraia Survey District, Hawke's Bay Land District*

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the road described in the Schedule hereto traverses Maori land and has been used by the public as a public road and has been formed, improved, or maintained out of public funds:

And whereas the Maori Land Court, by an order made on the 23rd day of April 1951 and issued pursuant to section 484 of the Maori Land Act 1931, ordered and declared the said road to be a public road:

And whereas the said Court is of the opinion that it is in the public interest that the said road should be proclaimed as a public road, and a notification to that effect has been forwarded to the Minister of Lands in terms of section 486 of the Maori Land Act 1931:

And whereas it is now expedient that the said road should be proclaimed as a public road:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 487 of the Maori Land Act 1931, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as a public road the road described in the Schedule hereto.

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 19 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Lands and of the Minister of Forests, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being part of a provisional State forest reserve set apart by Proclamation dated the 21st day of January 1946 and gazetted on the 25th day of that month, is required for settlement purposes; and, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, such land shall, from and after the day of the gazetting hereof, cease to be provisional State forest land and shall become Crown land available for sale, lease, reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of the Land Act 1948.
