1. (1) This Order may be cited as the South Otago Metropolitan Milk District Constitution Order 1952. (2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of May

1952

2. Those parts of New Zealand consisting of the Boroughs of Balclutha and Kaitangata, and that portion of the County of Bruce described in the Schedule hereto, are hereby constituted and declared a milk district under the Milk Act 1944, with the name of the "South Otago Milk District".

3. The Balclutha Milk District Constitution Order 1945,* and the Balclutha Milk District Constitution Order 1945, Amendment No. 1[†], are hereby revoked.
