This licence is issued under the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, and is subject thereto and to the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and to all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

3. System of Supply

The system of supply shall be an alternating current system as described in paragraph (d) of clause 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.

4. Duration of Licence

Unless sooner lawfully determined, this licence shall continue in force until the 31st day of March 1955 or until the licensee's premises have been brought within the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electricpower District, whichever is the earlier.
