RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE AS SECURITY FOR REDEMPTION LOAN 1953, OF £18,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Dunedin City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £18,000, authorized to be raised by the Dunedin City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of redeeming at maturity portion of the outstanding liability in respect of the Renewal Loan 1933, of £250,000, the said Dunedin City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one halfpenny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property of the City of Dunedin, comprising the whole of the City of Dunedin; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first (1st) day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five (5) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
