353 (8) (c)	Centrifugal, single stage, designed to take delivery pipes not exceeding 3¼ inches in internal diameter, or having a capacity equivalent to a head of water not exceeding 100 feet (43·3 lb. per square inch) and designed for use with clear water, milk, buttermilk, cream, and similar low viscosity, non-corrosive or slightly corrosive liquids	32-2/62/4
353 (8) (c)	Piston or reciprocating, hand or power operated, other than steam pumps or spray pumps, designed to take delivery pipes not exceeding 2¾ inches in internal diameter, or having a capacity equivalent to a head of water not exceeding 600 feet (260 lb. per square inch) and designed for use with non-corrosive or slightly corrosive liquids	32-2/62/4
