

## WAIMEA ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Waimea Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £50,000, known as the Border Area Loan 1951, authorized to be raised by the Waimea Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of reticulating the Border Special Area, the said Waimea Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny and one-eighth of a penny (1½d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the remaining portion of the Board's District which has not already been included in the special rating areas, described in resolutions making special rates and appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* for the year 1948, at page 342 thereof, and for the year 1949, at page 1790 thereof; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
