**W**HEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto has been duly set apart as a reserve for recreation purposes: And whereas, in the opinion of the Governor-General, it is expedient to vest the said reserve in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Auckland:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 9 of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares that, from and after the day of the date hereof, the reserve described in the Schedule hereto shall become vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Auckland, in trust, for recreation purposes.

**P**URSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby licences and permits Leslie Gerald Trounson (hereinafter called the "licensee", which term shall include his executors, administrators, or assigns unless the context requires a different construction), to use and occupy a part of the foreshore in the Taieri River, as shown on plans marked M.D. 9378 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of the use of a wharf as shown on the said plans, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall so far as applicable, apply hereto.
2. The premium payable by the licensee shall be £5 (five pounds) and the annual sum so payable £3 (three pounds).
3. The term of the licence shall be fourteen years from the 1st day of August 1952.
4. The licensee shall not at any time leave on the roadside any fish boxes or fish pots or any other gear.
