Exemption Order Under the Motor Drivers Regulations 1940

A motor-driver's licence issued under the Motor Drivers Regu-lations 1940, to the persons described in Column 1 of the Schedule hereunder may authorize them to drive a heavy trade motor in the course of their employment for the employers described in Column 2 of the said Schedule, but shall not authorize them, while they are under the age of eighteen years, to drive a heavy motor for any other purpose.
