BULLER ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Buller Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges of the loan of £4,910, authorized to be raised by the Buller Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of the purchase or construction of buildings and purchase of miscellaneous plant and equipment the said Buller Electric-power Board hereby raises and levies a special rate of one penny and decimal four one of a penny (1.41d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Buller Electric-power Board District comprising the whole of the County of Buller and the Borough of Westport, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty-four years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The said special rate is the same rate made and levied by the said Board on the 15th day of March 1951 and the 13th day of March 1952, and not additional thereto.
