WHEREAS by Orders in Council made on the respective dates specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto consent was given **VV** to the raising by the Napier City Council (hereinafter called the said local authority) of the respective loans stated in the first column of the said Schedule, subject in each case to the determinations set forth in such Orders in Council :

Of the said Schedule, subject in each case to the determinations set forth in such Orders in Council: And whereas the authorities conferred by the said Orders in Council have not been exercised: And whereas it is expedient to vary the determinations of each respective loan in so far as such determinations apply to the raising of the sum specified in the third column of the said Schedule opposite each loan (hereinafter called the said sum): Now; therefore, pursuant to section 11 of the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926, as set out in section 29 of the Finance Act 1932 (No. 2), His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby varies in respect of each loan referred to in the Schedule hereto certain of the aforesaid determinations in respect of the raising of such loan in so, for each such determinations apply to the raising of the said sum by prescribing as follows: in so far as such determinations apply to the raising of the said sum, by prescribing as follows :-

 In lieu of the term as specified in the Order in Council authorizing the raising of such loan, the term for which the said sum or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed twelve (12) years.
 In lieu of the rate of interest as specified in the Order in Council authorizing the raising of such loan, the rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said sum or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding four pounds (£4) per centum per annum.
 In lieu of repayment by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments of principal and interest, as specified in the Order in Council authorizing the raising of such loan, the said local authority shall, before raising the said sum or any part thereof, make provision for the repayment thereof by establishing a sinking fund under the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, or under such other statutory enactment as may be applicable, and shall thereafter make payments to such sinking fund at intervals of not more than one year at a rate or rates ere centum

be applicable, and shall thereafter make payments to such sinking fund at intervals of not more than one year at a rate or rates per centum which shall be not less the rate then stated in the fourth column of the said Schedule opposite each such loan, such payments to be made in respect of every part of the said sum for the time being so borrowed and not repaid, the first such payment to be made not later than one year after the first day from which interest to the lender or lenders is computed on the said sum or any part thereof so raised.
