

Price Order No. 1414 (Amendment No. 1 of Price Order No. 1393) (Eggs)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 1414, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order 1393\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 13th day of October 1952.
3. The principal Order is hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules thereto, and substituting the following Schedules:—

Price Order No. 1415 (Amendment No. 1 of Price Order No. 1394) (Eggs) South Island, Excluding Nelson Marketing Area and Blenheim and Picton Districts

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 1415 and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1394\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 13th day of October 1952.
3. The principal Order is hereby amended by revoking clause 7 and 8 thereof and substituting the following clauses:—
