THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on Monday, 3 November 1952:—

"In pursuance and in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and its amendments the Wellington City Council hereby resolves

as follows:—

"'That for the purpose of providing the interest, repayment of principal sinking fund and other charges on a loan of two hundred and sixty-five thousand six hundred pounds (£265,600) to be known as the Wellington City Water-supply Loan 1920 Renewal Loan 1952 of £265,600 authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of redeeming at maturity the outstanding liability in respect of the Wellington City Water-supply Loan 1920 Renewal Loan 1940 of five hundred and thirty-seven thousand six hundred pounds (£537,600) the Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three hundred and sixty-six eight-hundredths of a penny (\$\frac{2}{2}\fr City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three hundred and sixty-six eight-hundredths of a penny (\(^{\frac{8}{6}}\)\,\frac{6}{8}\)\,\text{d},\) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan being a period of eight (8) years or until the loan is fully paid off?."
