Redefining Boundaries of the Borough of Blenheim, the County of Marlborough, and the Omaka and Wairau Ridings of the County of Marlborough

PURSUANT to section 147 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1933, the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby defines, as set out in the Schedule hereto, the boundaries of the Borough of Blenheim, the County of Marlborough, and the Omaka and Wairau Ridings of the County of Marlborough, the previous boundaries having been altered by Order in Council made under the said Act dated the 17th day of March 1952, and published in *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 23 of the 20th day of March 1952.

SCHEDULE**BOUNDARIES OF THE BOROUGH OF BLENHEIM**

ALL that area in the Land District of Marlborough bounded by a line commencing on the south side of the old Renwick Road at the north-eastern corner of part Lot 3, D.P. 61, being part Section 53, Omaka District; thence proceeding southerly by the eastern boundary of Section 53 aforesaid and its continuation to the centre-line of Fulton Street; thence westerly by the said centre-line to the centre-line of Colemans Road; thence southerly by the said centre-line to a point opposite the intersection of the left bank of Fulton Creek and the western side of Colemans Road; thence westerly by a right line to the aforesaid intersection; thence southerly by the western side of Colemans Road to the right bank of Fulton Creek; thence westerly by the said right bank to its intersection with the southern boundary of Lot 59 of Section 53, Omaka; thence westerly by the said southern boundary and its continuation to the centre-line of Murphys Road; thence southerly by the said centre-line to a point opposite the southern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 1016; thence westerly by a right line to the roadside and by the aforesaid southern boundary of Lot 2 to the eastern boundary of Lot 7, D.P. 1016; thence southerly by the said eastern boundary and the eastern boundary of Lot 8, D.P. 307, and westerly by the southern boundary of Lot 8 aforesaid to the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 1364; thence southerly by the eastern boundary of Lot 1 and its continuation to the centre-line of the Middle Renwick Road; thence easterly by the said centre-line to a point opposite the continuation of the eastern boundary of part Lot 11, D.P. 676; thence southerly by the aforesaid continuation and eastern boundary to the northern boundary of Lot 12, D.P. 676; thence easterly along the northern boundary aforesaid to the intersection with a line parallel to Battys Road, being the continuation of the eastern boundary of Lot 14, D.P. 676; thence southerly by the aforesaid line across Lakin Street and by the aforesaid eastern boundary to the northern boundary of Lot 16, D.P. 676; thence easterly by the aforesaid northern boundary and its continuation to the centre-line of Battys Road; thence southerly by that centre-line to a point on the continuation of the northern boundary of Lot 35 of Section 7, Omaka; thence easterly and southerly by the northern and eastern boundaries of Lot 35 aforesaid to the northern boundary
