Building Re-construction Loan 1948, of £3,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and of all other powers and authorities thereunto it enabling the Oamaru Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £3,000, authorized to be raised by the Oamaru Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for reconstructing the Athenaeum Building and for works and purchases incidental thereto, the Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirteen one-hundredths of a penny (0·13d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Oamaru; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable half-yearly on the 23rd days of the months of June and December in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £250,000 (two hundred and fifty thousand pounds) Road Works and General Development Loan 1952, £250,000, authorized to be raised by the Mount Albert Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of carrying out road works and general development, the said Mount Albert Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of twenty-six one-hundredths of a penny (0·26d.) in the pound upon the rateable value on the basis of the capital value of all rateable property in the Borough of Mount Albert; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
