CONDITIONS

Implied Conditions

1. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

2. In respect of the electric lines hereby authorized, the licensee shall comply with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regula-tions 1934, and with all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

3. The system of supply shall be as described in paragraph (d) of Regulation 21–01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, and shall be a direct-current system.

DUBATION OF LICENCE

4. Unless sooner lawfully determined this licence shall continue in force until the 31st day of March 1973.

SCHEDULE

LINES for the supply of electrical energy by the system of supply hereinbefore described commencing from the licensee's generator shed situated in Lot 19 of Section 50, and proceeding in a north-easterly direction to a pole situated in Lot 19 of Section 50 aforesaid, and thence :-
