CENTRAL WAIKATO ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Special Loan 1952, £100,000

NOTICE is hereby given that at a meeting of the Central Waikato Electric-power Board, held on the 19th day of November 1952, the following resolution was passed:—

"In pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and its amendments and all other Acts and powers it thereunto enabling, the Central Waikato Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows: That for the purpose of providing principal, interest, and other charges on the Board's Special Loan 1952, £100,000, authorized to be raised by the Central Waikato Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of financing further reticulation within the Central Waikato Electric-power District, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal 0.095 of a penny in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Central Waikato Electric-power District as the same is defined by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the 27th day of July 1939 at page 2042, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable annually on the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
