A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Maori Purposes Act 1939, I, Sir Humphrey Francis O'Leary, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby vary the Proclamation made on the 28th day of August 1952, and published in the *Gazette* on the 4th day of September 1952, at page 1437, by excluding therefrom the land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

GISBORNE LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Matakaoa County, containing by admeasurement 13 acres 3 roods 20 perches, more or less, and situated in Block II, Whangaparaoa Survey District, and known as Section I, Block II, Whangaparaoa Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto was, by an order of the Maori Land Court made on the 11th day of May 1944, duly laid out as a road-line in pursuance of sections 162, 477, 478, and 479 of the Maori Land Act 1931:

And whereas the said Court is of the opinion that it is in the public interest that the said road-line should be proclaimed as a public road, and a notification to that effect has been forwarded to the Minister of Lands, in terms of section 486 of the said Act:

And whereas one month's notice in writing of the intention to proclaim the said road-line as a public road has been given by the Surveyor-General to the local authority of the district concerned, in terms of subsection (2) of section 487 of the said Act:

And whereas it is now expedient that the said road-line should be proclaimed as a public road:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 487 of the Maori Land Act 1931, I, Sir Humphrey Francis O'Leary, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as a public road the road-line described in the Schedule hereto.
