heavy rainfalls were reported east of the Manawatu Gorge on the night of the 27 th when the depression was centred over Northland. Pressures had been rising slowly but steadily in the south and on the 27 th an anticyclone enveloped the South Island.

The weather began to improve in the North Island on the 29 th as the depression moved away to the north, but many. thunderstorms were reported during that afternoon in the Auckland Province.

With the collapse of the anticyclone over New Zealand on the 29 th, highest pressures were to be found over the North Tasman Sea. A weak cold front associated with a depression far to the south crossed the South Island on the 30th, causing a few showers in the west and south. At the end of the month a weak anticyclone lay to the north of the Dominion, while a vigorous depression which had sụddenly developed in the South Tasman Sea was rapidly approaching Southland.
