RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance of the powers vested in it by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, and all other powers (if any) enabling it in that behalf, the Havelock North Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of four thousand three hundred pounds (£4,300) to be known as ‘Plant Loan 1952’, authorized to be raised by the Council under the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, for the purpose of the purchase of plant consisting of a power grader and a tractor-loader with compressor, the Havelock North Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.32 pence in the pound (£) on the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Havelock North; and that such rate shall be an annual recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and shall be payable on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years, or until the loan is fully repaid.”
