Revoking the Reservation Over Portion of a Scenic Reserve in the Otago Land District

C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is VV portion of a reserve duly set apart for scenic purposes:

And whereas the said land is no longer suitable for scenic purposes by reason of the absence of bush of scenic value

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 8 of the Scenery Preservation Amendment Act 1910, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the reservation for scenic purposes over the land described in the Schedule hereto.

OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 38.5 perches, more or less, being part Sections 58 and 59, Block IX, North Harbour and Blueskin Survey District, and being part of the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Volume 121, folio 217 (Otago Registry). As the same is more particularly delinated on the plan marked L. and S. 4/119A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red. (S.O. plan 11693).
