356 (1) (c)	Herb cutters, hand operated, comprising cutting discs mounted on a common axle or axles and fitted with handles. Examples, Minimincers, Tala Lightning mincers	66-3/410/5
409	Handles, wooden, for tools, fitted with minor metal attachments such as ferrules, metal discs, metal straps, &c.	66-15/5
