## THE RIGHT HON S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

THEREAS by section 31 of the Rabbit Nuisance Act 1928 W it is enacted that the Governor-General, at the request of the Board of any rabbit district, may, by Order in Council, alter and redefine the boundaries of its district:

And whereas the district known as the Wairarapa East Rabbit District has been constituted under and for the purposes of the said Act:

And whereas the Board of the said district has, pursuant to the said section 31 of the said Act, requested that the boundaries of its district be altered and redefined by including an additional area therein:

And whereas the consent of a majority of the persons in such additional area qualified to be enrolled on the ratepayers' list for the said district has been given to the inclusion of such additional area in the said district:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district accordingly:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the said Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby—

- (1) Alters and redefines the boundaries of the said district so constituted as aforesaid:
- (2) Declares that the boundaries of the said district shall be those set forth in the Schedule hereto; and, further,
- (3) Declares that this Order in Council shall come into force on the day following publication hereof in the Gazette.

## SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE WAIRARAPA EAST RABBIT DISTRICT

BOUNDARIES OF THE WARARAPA EAST RABBIT DISTRICT ALL that area in the Wellington Land District situate in the Survey Districts of Tiffin, Otohoua, Rewa, Huangarua, Wai-nuioru, and Kaiwhata bounded by a line commencing at a point on the southern side of the Masterton-Castlepoint via Tainui Main Highway where it joins the south-western boun-dary of Section 514, Whareama Block, Block VII, Otahoua Survey District; thence south-easterly along that boundary and the western boundary of Section 604; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the western and southern boundaries of the said Section 604 to the western boundary of Section 546; thence in an easterly direction generally by western and sourceasterly along the western and soundary of Section 546; thence in an easterly direction generally by the western boundary of Section 546, the northern boundary of the land shown on Land Transfer Plan B/201, the northern and north-eastern boundaries of the land shown on Land Transfer Plan B/198, the northern boundary of the land shown on Land Transfer Plan B/205, the northern boundary of Lot 5, D.P. 2303, and the northern boundary of the land shown on Land Transfer Plan B/200 to the permanent State forest as described in *Gazette* of 1897, page 2188; thence in a north-easterly direction by the eastern boundaries of Sections 667 and 662, Whareama Block, Block VI, Rewa Survey District; thence in an easterly direction generally by the southern boundaries of Sections 648, 649, and 650, the western boundary of Section 613, the southern boundaries of Sections 613 and 677, the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10442, to the East Coast Road, by the crossing of that road, and thence Block, and the northern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10422, to the East Coast Road, by the crossing of that road, and thence in a northerly direction by the eastern side of that road to the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 4523; thence in an easterly direction generally by that southern boundary and the northern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 4523, to the Whareama River; thence by the right bank of that river to the sea-cost: thence in a southerly direction generally by the sea-Biver; thence by the right bank of that river to the sea-coast; thence in a southerly direction generally by the sea-coast to the Kaiwhata Biver; thence in a westerly direction generally by the left bank of that river to the eastern boundary of the land shown on D.P. 4281; thence by the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of the said D.P. 4281 to the right bank of the Kaiwhata River, by the crossing of that river, and thence in a northerly direction generally by the western boundary of Section 1, Block V, the western boundary of Section 12, Block IV, Kaiwhata Survey District, and the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of Te Maipi 7c 3B; thence by the south-eastern boundaries of Te Maipi 7c 6; thence north-westerly by the northern boundaries of Te Maipi 7c 6, 7c 5B, and 7c 5A; thence southerly by the eastern boundary north-westerly by the northern boundaries of Te Maipi 7c 6, 7c 5B, and 7c 5A; thence southerly by the eastern boundary of Te Maipi 7c 4; thence north-westerly by the north-eastern boundary of section 1, Block I, Kaiwhata Survey District, the crossing of a road, again by the north-eastern boundary of Section 1, the crossing of the Kaiwhata River, again by Section 1, and again by the crossing of the Kaiwhata River; thence southerly generally by the right bank of the Kaiwhata River to the northern boundary of Run 49, Block I,

Kaiwhata, and Block IV, Wainuioru Survey Districts; thence westerly by the northern boundary of the said Run 49; thence westerly by the northern boundary of the said Run 49; thence south-westerly by the western boundaries of the said Run 49 and of Run 48, Block IV, Wainuioru Survey District, the north-western boundaries of Section 7, the western boundary of Section 248, Block VIII, and the northern boundary of Section 267, Block VII, Wainuioru Survey District, to a road, as shown on Survey Office plan numbered 17011, by the eastern side of that road to the Gladstone – East Coast Road, by the crossing of that road, and by the southern side of that road to the eastern boundary of Section 271, Block VII, Wainuioru Survey District; thence by the eastern and southern boundaries of the said Section 271, the southern boundary of Section 270, Block VII, the western boundary of Section 277, Block XI, Wainuioru Survey District and the crossing of roads, the southern boundary of the said Section 277, and the crossing of a road, the western boundary of Section 287, Block XI, Wainuioru Survey District and the crossing of roads, the southern boundary of the said Section 277, and the crossing of a road, the western boundary of Section 287, Subdivision 2, and the crossings of a road to a road forming the northern boundary of Section 292; thence south-easterly along that road to a point opposite the intersection of that road and the old road passing through Section 292; thence south-westerly generally along the northern side of that old road to the eastern boundary of Section 291, Block XI, Wainuioru Survey District; thence in a southerly direction generally by the eastern boundary of Section 291 to the southern corner of that Section; thence in a westerly direction by the southern boundaries of Sections 291 and 290 to the junction of the Waipunga Stream with the Wainuioru River; thence in a southerly direction along the left bank of the Wainuioru River to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 294, Block X, Wainuioru Survey District; thence westerly to and along that boundary to the right bank of the Wainuioru River; thence north-west generally by that right bank to the southern boundary of Section 3, Block IX, Wainuioru Survey District; thence westerly by the southern boundaries of Section 10 aforesaid to the north-eastern boun-dary of Section 8, Mahupuku Settlement; thence north-westerly along that boundary to and across the Whangachu Valley Road and again that boundary to and across the Whangachu River and southerly generally along its right bank to the north-eastern boundary of Lot 2 on D.P. 2525; thence north-westerly generally along that boundary to and across the Whangachu River and southerly generally along its right bank to the north-eastern boundary of Lot 2 on D.P. 2525; thence north-westerly generally along that boundary to the eastern boundary of Section 119, Ahiaruhe Block; thence northerly generally along the eastern boundaries of Sections 119 and 118, Ahiaruhe Block, the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 119 and 118, Ahiaruhe Block, the s Block, the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 115 and 116, Aniatule Block, the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, on Land Transfer Plan A/2052, the north-western boundary of Section 113, Ahiaruhe Block, to the south-western corner of Section 112, Ahiaruhe Block; thence easterly and northerly generally along the south-eastern boundary of Section 112 aforesaid, along the south-eastern boundary of Section 112 aforesaid, to and across the Carterton-Longbush Main Highway (Millers Road), and the eastern side of that highway to the Ahiaruhe Road; thence westerly generally across that road along its western side to the Ahiaruhe Stream and by that stream to the north-western boundary of Section 108, Ahiaruhe Block; thence north-easterly along that boundary to and across a road, the north-western boundaries of Sections 107 and 103, Ahiaruhe Block, and north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Section 106, Ahiaruhe Block, to the Ruamahanga River; thence north-easterly generally along the left bank of that river to the north-easterly generally along the north-eastern, south-eastern, and south-western boundaries of the said Section 6 to the northern corner of Section 104, Ahiaruhe said Section 6 to the northern corner of Section 104, Ahiaruhe Block; thence easterly generally along the north-western and south-western boundaries of the Section 104 aforesaid, to and Block; thence easterly generally along the north-western and south-western boundaries of the Section 104 aforesaid, to and across Ahiaruhe Road, and along its south-eastern side to the north-eastern boundary of Lot 14 on D.P. 4578; thence south-easterly and north-easterly generally along that north-eastern boundary, the south-eastern boundary of Lot 13 on D.P. 4578 to the south-western corner of the land described in C.T. 352/150, Wellington Registry, being also part Section 14, Ahiaruhe Block; thence along the north-western boundary of that land to the Makahaka Stream; thence easterly generally by that stream to the northern boundary of part Tuarawhati Block as shown on Land Transfer Plan A/2665; thence south-easterly by that boundary to the south-east boundaries of Sections 15 and 16, Tupurupuru Block, as shown on Land Transfer Plans A/2663 and D.P. 6099 to the southern side of a road intersecting Lot 2, D.P. 6099, by that road to the Martinborough-Masterton via Gladstone Main Highway; thence in a northerly direction by that highway to the southern most corner of Lot 4, D.P. 7309; thence towards the north-west by the southern boundaries of Lots 4 and 3, D.P. 7309, to the left bank of the Ruamahanga River; thence northerly by that left bank to its junction with the Whangaehu River; thence in a north-easterly direction by that river to the south side of Moores Road; thence towards the wester by a line, being the production of the south side of Moores Road to the eastern side of a road through Section 7, Block I, Otahoua Survey District, and also forming the western boundary of Sections 6, 5, and 3, Block VI, Otahoua Survey District, to the southern side of the Masterton-Castlepoint via Tainui Main Highway; thence easterly by the southern side of that high-way to the south-western boundary of Section 514, Whareama Highway; thence easterly by the southern side of that high-way to the south-western boundary of Section 514, Whareama Block, Block VII, Otahoua Survey District, the point of
