RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Tararua Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of £5,000 (to be known as Akitio Loan 1953), authorized to be raised by the Tararua Electric-power Board in New Zealand by special order under the above-mentioned Act and of all other Acts and authorities it thereunto enabling for the purpose of further reticulation in the Akitio County, the said Tararua Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.1485d.
