Notice of Intention to Take Land

In the matter of the Public Works Act 1928

PUBLIC notice is hereby given that the Waikato County Council proposes to execute a certain public work; to wit, the formation of a road, for which purpose the lands described in the Schedule hereto require to be taken by the Waikato County Council under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1928, sections 22 and 23. RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Sewerage Renewal Loan 1952

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Alexandra Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

“ That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £2,250, to be known as Sewerage Renewal Loan 1952, authorized to be raised by the Alexandra Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of redeeming at maturity the outstanding liability in respect of portion, namely, £4,500, of the Sewerage Loan 1936—£7,000, the said Alexandra Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-eighths (³/₈ths.) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Alexandra; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”
