PURSUANT to the Electric-power Boards Act 1925, His
Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with
the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby revokes,
as from the date of the next general election of the representa-
tives of the constituent districts of the North Canterbury
Electric-power District, the Order in Council dated the 23rd
day of March 1938 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*
on the 24th day of the same month at page 512, apportion-
ing representation on the North Canterbury Electric-power
Board, and hereby determines, in lieu thereof, that on and
after the said date the number of representatives of each
constituent district on the said Board shall be the number
specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that
constituent district; and further determines that the consti-
tuent districts which are bracketed together in the first column
of the Schedule hereto are hereby constituted combined districts
for the purposes of the said Act, and that the local authority

County of Kaikoura shall be held on the date of the said
general election.
