LEVIN BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Levin Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of fifty thousand pounds (£50,000), authorized to be raised by the Levin Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of carrying out the sewerage reticulation of the north-western portion of the Borough, as required by a requisition issued under section 22 of the Health Act 1920, the said Levin Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-hundred-and-sixty-four four-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{364}{400}$.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Levin, comprising the whole of the Borough of Levin; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

HUTT VALLEY ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION LEVYING RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Hutt Valley Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the instalments of principal and interest and other charges on a loan of £20,000 (known as Building Additional Loan 1953), authorized to be raised by the Hutt Valley Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, to provide additional moneys to meet the added expense in the erection of the Board's new administrative building, the said Hutt Valley Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of six one-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{6}{100}$.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Hutt Valley Electric-power Board's District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off."

The above resolution was passed by the Hutt Valley Electric-power Board on 21 May 1953.
