Board of Trade Notice No. 67—Review of Import Licensing

IT is hereby notified that the Board of Trade has examined the objections lodged to the proposed exemption from import licensing of the following items in the Import Licensing Schedule and has decided not to recommend de-control until after a review of the appropriate tariff duties takes place.

Tariff Item	Description
Ex. 300 (2) (c)	Paper, n.e.i., including tin-foil paper, and gummed paper, n.e.i., in rolls less than 10 inches wide, except such rolls specially suited for industrial or similar purposes in such widths not exceeding 2 inches, as the Minister may determine (excluding decorative crepe paper).
Ex. 300 (2) (d)	Gummed tape paper and gummed stay paper in rolls, n.e.i.
