## Dredging in Progress

(Former N.Z. Notice to Mariners No. 44/53 hereby cancelled)

DREDGING operations are being carried out in Victoria Channel, commencing at Dunedin, for the purpose of widening and deepening the channel to 24 feet L.W. with a bottom width of 250 feet on the straights and 300 to 400 feet on the bends.

Channel piles will be drawn as necessary and replaced approximately 25 feet further back as dredging proceeds.

Moorings are laid in the vicinity and mariners should proceed with caution when entering or leaving the port and passing the dredger.
