# HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the 17th day of February 1953 and subject to the determinations as to borrowing and repayment therein set out, consent was given to the raising in New Zealand by the Opotiki Borough Council (hereinafter called the said local authority) of the sum of twelve thousand pounds (£12,000) (hereinafter called the said sum) being portion of a loan of sixty thousand pounds (£60,000) known as '' Sewerage Loan 1952 '':

And whereas the said sum has not yet been raised and it is expedient to cancel the determinations aforesaid in respect of the said sum and make new determinations in lieu thereof:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 11 of the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926, as set out in section

29 of the Finance Act 1932 (No. 2), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby cancels the aforesaid determinations in respect of the said sum and in lieu thereof makes the following determinations:

1. The term for which the said sum or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed ten (10) years.

2. The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said sum or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding four pounds ( $\pounds 4$ ) per centum per annum.

- 3. The said sum shall be repaid as follows:
  (a) By twenty equal payments of three hundred and forty-five pounds four shillings and fourpence (£345 4s. 4d.), one of such payments to be made at the end of every half-year commencing from the date on which the said sum is raised. Each such half-yearly payment shall be applied first in payment of interest computed at the rate of four pounds (£4) per centum per annum on the amount of principal for the time being outstanding at the beginning of each such half-year in respect of the said sum, and the balance of such half-yearly payment in reduction of such principal.
  (b) By a payment at the end of the tenth year from
- (b) By a payment in reduction of such principa.
  (b) By a payment at the end of the tenth year from the date of the raising of the said sum of a sum equal to the amount to which the principal of the said sum has been reduced in accordance with the preceding paragraph (a) hereof after payment of the aforesaid twenty half-yearly payments.

4. The payments referred to in clause 3 hereof shall be made in New Zealand, and no other payment shall be made out of loan moneys.

5. The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the raising of the said sum or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed onehalf per centum of any amount raised.

6. No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
