Notice by the Public Trustee Under the Public Trust Office Act 1908 (Part III) and its Amendments

WHEREAS it has been reported to the Public Trustee that Edward William Newbert, formerly of Auckland, is the owner of ten fully paid £1 shares in Entertainments (N.Z.), Limited, and the sum of £29 representing accumulated dividends held by the said company on behalf of the said Edward William Newbert: And whereas the value of such shares and dividends does not exceed one thousand pounds (£1,000): And whereas it is not known where the said Edward William Newbert is or whether he is alive or dead: And whereas Part III of the Public Trust Office Act 1908 and its amendments provides (*inter alia*) that when it is not known where the owner of any real or personal property is or whether he is alive or dead, and the value of such real or personal property does not exceed one thousand pounds (£1,000) and that the exercise of the powers set out in section 87 of the said Act is advisable in the interests of such owner or of any other person, the Public Trustee may by notice in the *Gazette* declare his intention to take possession of such property and to exercise the powers conferred upon him by the said section 87 of the Public Trust Office Act 1908, and may thereafter exercise such powers without application to the Supreme Court:

Now the Public Trustee hereby gives notice that pursuant to Part III of the said Act he intends to take possession of the property above mentioned and to exercise in respect thereof the powers conferred upon him under and by virtue of the provisions of the said section 87 of the Public Trust Office Act 1908, as amended by section 21 of the Finance Act (No. 2) 1936.

Pharmacy Industry
