MOUNT MAUNGANUI BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Proposal to Raise Fire Appliances Loan 1953 (£3,500)

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and by all other Acts and powers thereunto enabling it, the Mount Maunganui Borough Council hereby resolves:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on the Fire Appliances Loan (£3,350) 1953, authorized under the above-mentioned powers, the said Mount Maunganui Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three twenty-sixths of a penny (3/26d.) in the pound (£) (on the basis of unimproved values) on all the rateable property in the Borough of Mount Maunganui, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be repayable half-yearly on the first day of April and the first day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
