WHEREAS by Orders in Council made on the respective dates specified in the third column of the Schedule hereto, consent W was given to the raising by the respective local authorities enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule of the espective loans stated in the second column of the said Schedule, subject in each case to the determinations set forth in such Orders in Council:

And whereas the authorities conferred by the said Orders in Council have not been exercised in respect of each respective

And whereas the authorities conferred by the said Orders in Council have not been exercised in respect of each respective loan to the extent specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule opposite each such loan: And whereas it is expedient to cancel the determinations aforesaid of each respective loan in so far as such determinations apply to the raising of the sum specified in the fifth column of the said Schedule opposite each such loan (hereinafter called the said sum) and make new determinations in lieu thereof: Now, therefore, pursuant to section 11 of the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926 as set out in section 29 of the Finance Act 1932 (No. 2), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby cancels in respect of each loan referred to in the Schedule hereto the aforesaid determinations in respect of the raising of such loan in so far as such determinations apply to the raising of the said sum, and in lieu thereof makes the following determinations: following determinations:

1. The term for which the said sum or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed ten (10) years. 2. The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said sum or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding four pounds (£4) per centum per annum.

- (a) The said sum shall be repaid as follows:
 (a) By twenty equal payments of the amount specified in the sixth column of the said Schedule opposite such sum, one of such payments to be made at the end of every half-year, commencing from the date on which the said sum is raised. Each such half-yearly payment shall be applied first in payment of interest computed at the rate of four pounds (£4) per centum per annum on the amount of principal for the time being outstanding at the beginning of each such half-year in respect of the said sum and the balance of such half-yearly payment in reduction of such principal.
- (b) By a payment at the end of the tenth year from the date of the raising of the said sum of a sum equal to the amount to which the principal of the said sum has been reduced in accordance with the preceding paragraph (a) hereof after payment of the aforesaid twenty half-yearly payments.
 4. The payments referred to in clause 3 hereof shall be made in New Zealand and no such payment shall be made out

of loan moneys.

5. The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the raising of the said sum or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of any amount raised. 6. No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
