nevertheless that those powers shall in no way derogate from or limit his general executive and administrative authority in so preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws and regulations in force in the Dependency in the same manner, and with the same powers and authorities, as the various executive and administrative authorities have in New Zealand for carrying out and enforcing the laws of New Zealand: To hold that office and exercise the duties thereof during pleasure. during pleasure.

As witness the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General, as the Governor of the Ross Dependency, this 27th day of August 1953.
