

*Releasing Land from the Provisions of Part I of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936 (Hokianga Development Scheme)*

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 4 of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936, the Board of Maori Affairs hereby revokes, so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, a certain notice dated the 15th day of September 1930 and published in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 66 of 25 September 1930 at page 2850, whereby the provisions of subsection (3) of section 23 of the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Adjustment Act 1929 (now Part I of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936) were applied to, *inter alia*, the said land.
