IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Waipawa County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of five thousand nine hundred and and other charges on a loan of five thousand nine hundred and forty pounds being part of a loan of forty-five thousand pounds (£45,000) authorized to be raised by the Waipawa County Council for providing the Council's contribution under the Main Highways Act 1922 towards the construction or reconstruction of the main highways in the County of Waipawa, for providing the necessary plant and machinery for same, and providing funds to erect bridges and culverts in the said County, the said Waipawa County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirty-six one-hundredths (3%00ths) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Waipawa; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 15th day of August in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

"That the said rate so made and levied as is hereinabove provided shall be in confirmation of a rate for the same amount and for the same or similar purposes made and levied by the Council on the 11th day of May 1925 and confirmed by a resolution of the Council dated the 14th day of October 1940 and 10th day of July 1950."
