Revoking the Reservation Over Land in Canterbury Land District Reserved for Plantation Purposes

# [L.S.] C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (4) of section 171 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act 1924 and section 19 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal Act 1950, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the reservation for plantation purposes over the land described in the Schedule hereto.

WHEREAS the Scenery Preservation Board, constituted pursuant to the Scenery Preservation Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), has recommended that the land described in the Schedule hereto should be permanently reserved for scenic purposes, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation:

Now, therefore, pursuant to the said Act, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall be a scenic reserve under the said Act and subject to the provisions thereof.
