PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby makes the following amending Price Order:

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 1497, and shall be read with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1484\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 23rd day of

October 1953.

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by revoking clause 4 thereof and substituting the following new clause therefor:

#### APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

"4. This Order applies with respect to any poultry food sold as mash in New Zealand except Basic Poultry Ration or other poultry food to which Price Order No. 1496 applies."

4. The principal Order is hereby further amended by inserting the words "Price Order or a" before the words "special approved price" in each of clauses 5 (1), 6 (1), and 7 (1) thereof.
