and included in the Borough of Cronwell: And whereas pursuant to section 24 of the Local Govern-ment Commission Act 1946 the said petition was referred to the Local Government Commission:

And whereas pursuant to the Local Government Commission Act 1946 the Local Government Commission has approved as final a scheme bearing date the 10th day of September 1953, providing for the exclusion of the areas described in the Schedule to the said scheme from the County of Vincent and the inclusion of those areas in the Borough of Cromwell:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to give effect to the final scheme as hereinafter appearing: Now, therefore, pursuant to the Local Government Com-mission Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares that as on and from the 1st day of November 1953 the areas described in the Schedule hereto shall be excluded from the County of Vincent and included in the Borough of Cromwell, and, with the like advice and consent, hereby also declares that the alteration of boundaries of the said borough and the said county hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Municipal Corporations Act 1933.
