PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 4 of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936, the Board of Maori Affairs hereby revokes so far as it affects the land known as Otaramarac No. 1 and Waipapa 2b Blocks, a certain notice, dated the 29th day of May 1933 and published in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 46 of 22 June 1933 at page 1657, whereby the provisions of section 522 of the Maori Land Act 1931 (now Part I of the Maori Land Amendment Act 1936) were applied to, *inter alia*, the said land, and such land is hereby excluded from the Taheke Development Scheme.
