A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 18 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as permanent State forest land.

SCHEDULE

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT—AUCKLAND CONSERVANCY ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, containing by admeasurement 2,278 acres 3 roods, more or less, and being Sections 21, 22, 23, and 24, Block X, Waoku Survey District. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 7/42, deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red. (North Auckland plan S.O. 18595.)
