Authorizing Poronui Stations, Limited, to Use Water for the Purpose of Generating Electricity

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency **P** the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Excettive Council, hereby grants to Poronui Stations Limited, a company duly incorporated under the Companies Act 1933 and having its registered office at Taupo (hereinafter referred to as the licensee), a licence subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth to use water from the Taharua Stream, situated in Patehe Block, Block IX, Maruanui Survey District, in the County of Taupo, for the purpose hereinafter set forth.

CONDITIONS

IMPLIED CONDITIONS

1. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water Power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

2. This licence is issued under the Water Power Regu-lations 1934, and is subject thereto and to the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and to all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

UTILIZATION OF WATER AND LOCATION OF HEADWORKS

3. Water shall be used under this licence solely for the purpose of generating electricity and shall be used for such purpose at the point in the said stream situated in Patche Block, Block IX, Maruanui Survey District, as indicated on the plan marked S.H.D. 261, deposited in the office of the State Hydro-electric Department at Wellington.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

4. The licensee is hereby authorized, subject to the conditions hereof, to construct, maintain, and use the following works for the purpose of this licence, the position of the said works being indicated on the said plan S.H.D. 261:

- (a) A water-wheel situated in the said stream giving a static head of approximately 10 ft.
 (b) A power-house with all necessary equipment for generating electricity situated in Patche Block, Block IX, Maruanui Survey District.

SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

5. The system of supply shall be an alternating current system as described in paragraph (d) of regulation 21–01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.
