

DURATION OF LICENCE

6. Unless sooner lawfully determined; this licence shall continue in force until the 31st day of March 1974.

RENTAL

7. For the purpose of assessing the rental or annual sum payable in respect of this licence, the licensee may install a suitable maximum-demand indicator to the satisfaction of the Inspecting Engineer of the State Hydro-electric Department, and failing such installation the rental shall be assessed on the maximum generating capacity of the plant installed. The present plant is rated at 3 kilowatts.

NO RIGHT TO WATER CONFERRED

8. Nothing in this licence shall of itself confer upon the licensee any right to water.
