## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Pukekohe Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on the loan of £4,500 authorized to be raised by the Pukekohe Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of carrying out drainage and sewerage works required under a requisition issued by the Board of Health, the said Pukekohe Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirteen one-thousandths of a penny ( $\frac{13}{1000}$ od.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the whole of the Borough of Pukekohe; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
