## POVERTY BAY CATCHMENT BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Waipaoa River Flood-control Scheme Loan, 1952*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and amendments thereto, the Poverty Bay Catchment Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of one hundred and ninety-nine thousand four hundred and fifty pounds (£199,450) to be known as the Waipaoa River Flood-control Scheme Loan, 1952, authorized to be raised by the Poverty Bay Catchment Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing the Board's proportion of the cost of carrying out the Waipaoa River Flood-control Scheme the said Poverty Bay Catchment Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 4-615d. in the pound on the rateable capital value of all lands classified as 'A', 3-018d. in the pound on the rateable capital value of all lands classified as 'B', 1-775d. in the pound on the rateable capital value of all lands classified as 'C', 0-888d. in the pound on the rateable capital value of all lands classified as 'D', 0-355d. in the pound on the rateable capital value of all lands classified as 'E', and 0-071d. in the pound on the rateable capital value of all lands classified as 'F', within the Waipaoa River Flood-control Scheme Special Rating Area as defined by a Classification List prepared and determined pursuant to provisions of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and by payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-five (35) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”

The above resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Poverty Bay Catchment Board held on Thursday, the 12th day of February 1953.
