STATUTORY REGULATIONS

Under the Regulations Act 1936 statutory regulations of
general legislative force are no longer published in the *New
Zealand Gazette*, but are supplied under any one or more of
the following arrangements:—

- (1) All regulations serially as issued (punched for filing),
subscription £2 per calendar year in advance.
- (2) Annual volume (including index) bound in buckram,
£1 10s. (Volumes for years 1936-37 and 1939-42
are out of print.)
- (3) Serially as issued and annual bound volume, as in
(1) and (2) above, on combined subscription basis,
£3 3s. per calendar year in advance.
- (4) Separate regulations as issued.

The price of each regulation is printed thereon, facilitating
the purchase of extra copies.
