**SECOND SCHEDULE**

**CLOSED GAME AREAS**

AREAS are excepted from the operation of the open season in each acclimatization district as specified hereunder:

**ASHBURTON ACCLIMATIZATION DISTRICT**

(1) All that area of land in the Canterbury Land District, intersected by the Wakanui Creek, being Rural Sections 15104, 15510, 17411, and 16673, the property of the late Mr G. W. Leadley.

(2) The waters comprising the Rangitata River Lagoon situated between Reserves 99, 23552, 23267, Block IV, Coldstream Survey District, and the sea.

(3) The property of Messrs Ross Bros., Westerfield, being R.S. 28890, 28999, 29000, 29189, Blocks VI and X, Westerfield.
