

Exempting Land in the Nelson Land District from the Operation of Part III of the Coal Mines Act 1925

NOTICE

ALL that area of land in the Nelson Land District, situated in the Inangahua County, containing 24.2 perches, more or less, being Sections 744 and 745, Town of Reefton.

The Cook Islands Act 1915—Persons Qualified for Appointment as Assessors in Criminal Trials

PURSUANT to the Cook Islands Act 1915, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the nomination of persons qualified for appointment as assessors in criminal trials in the High Court of the Cook Islands, made by Warrant dated the 10th day of December 1951,* and in lieu thereof I hereby nominate the persons named in the following ten Schedules hereto as persons qualified for appointment as assessors under the said Act generally in criminal trials in the High Court of the Cook Islands where-soever those trials may be held (except in the Island of Niue), and I declare this Warrant shall take effect on the 1st day of March 1955.
