A PROCLAMATION

**P**URSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart together with the water rights appurtenant thereto reserved by Deed No. 35685 (R. 37/382), Nelson Registry, and the water rights and incidental rights appurtenant thereto created by Memorandum of Transfer No. 32903, Nelson Land Registry, subject to the said Deed No. 35685, for broadcasting purposes (transmitter site); and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 25th day of January 1955.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of Crown land set apart: 17 acres 2 roods 25 perches.

Being parts of Sections 75 and 76 (D.P. 3154), District of Waimea East.

Situated in Block VII, Waimea Survey District, Nelson R.D. (S.O. 9878.)
