Classification of Roads in Raglan County

PURSUANT to subclauses (6) and (10) of regulation 3 of the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1950 (as substituted by regulation 4 (1) of the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 8) the Commissioner of Transport hereby revokes those portions of the Warrant dated the 11th day of August 1950,* classifying roads in Raglan County, insofar as they apply to roads described in the Schedule hereto, and hereby approves the Raglan County Council's proposed classification, and proposed variation in the classification, of roads as set out in the Schedule hereto and situated in Raglan County.
