RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Finance Act 1921-22 and the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and all other powers and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Masterton Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and principal and any other charges on a loan of one hundred and seventy-three thousand two hundred and fifty pounds (£173,250) authorized to be raised by the Masterton Borough Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of carrying out extensions and improvements to the borough water and sewerage systems, the said Masterton Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two and one-fifth pence (2½d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) on all rateable property in the Borough of Masterton; and that such rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly in the month of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty (30) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
